

- \*\* Jamal Abdul Nasser was one of the most influential leaders of the Arab world in the 20<sup>th</sup> century. Nasser led the 1952 overthrow of the Egyptian monarchy and served as the President of Egypt between 1954 and 1970
- \*\*\* Following the 2012 announcement of the Church of Nativity and the Pilgrimage Route as an UNESCO World Heritage site, the Palestinian Authority installed many information plaques around the Old City and the Pilgrimage Route

#### The Carmelite Monastery

The monastery was founded by Sister Mariam Baouardy (Mary of Jesus the Crucified) from Ibilin village in the north. On 20 August 1875, Sister Baouardy, accompanied by ten of her fellow sisters, left their monastery in Pau/France to undertake the founding of the Carmel in Bethlehem. The building was inaugurated in November, 1876.

A building for the Society of Priests of the Sacred Heart of Jesus was added to the north-west of the convent in 1878, and a church was built adjacent to its eastern end in 1892. The church was dedicated to St. Joseph.

Mary of Jesus the Crucified, also known as the Little Arab, or Lily of Palestine, was beatified by Pope John Paul II on 13 November 1983 and was canonized on 17 May 2015 by Pope Francis.



\* Mariam Baouardy was born in 1846 to a Greek-Catholic family in the Galilean village of I'billin. She joined the Carmelite order in France in 1865 and was later involved in establishing Carmelite presence in India (1870) and Bethlehem (1876). Mariam Baouardy was canonized in 2015 by Pope Francis as one of the first two Palestine-born saints (the other is Marie-Alphonsine Danil Ghattas, foundress of the Rosary Sisters). St. Mariam Baouardy is AKA Mary of Jesus Crucified, The Little Arab, Lily of Palestine and Flower of the Orient (her biography)







#### A Son Promised to Abraham and Sarah



.... So he came to a Samaritan city called Sychar, near the plot of ground that Jacob had given to his son Joseph. Jacob's well was there, and Jesus, tired out by his journey, was sitting by the well. It was about noon. A Samaritan woman came to draw water, and Jesus said to her, "Give me a drink." (His disciples had gone to the city to buy food.) The Samaritan woman said to him, "How is it that you, a Jew, ask a drink of me, a woman of Samaria?" (Jews do not share things in common with Samaritans.)....Then the woman left her water jar and went back to the city. She said to the people, "Come and see a man who told me everything I have ever done! He cannot be the Messiah, can he?".... I sent you to reap that for which you did not labor. Others have labored, and you have entered into their labor." (John 4, 1-38)
