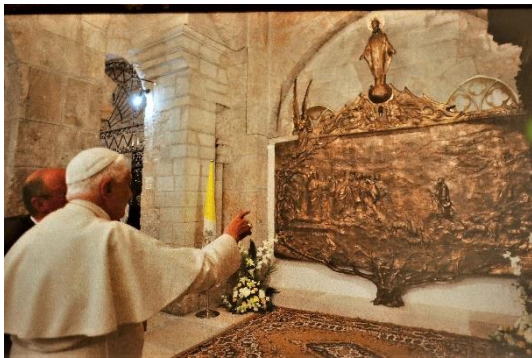
The Call of David

I am sending you to Jesse of Bethlehem, for I have chosen myself a king from among his sons (1 Samuel 16, 1-13)

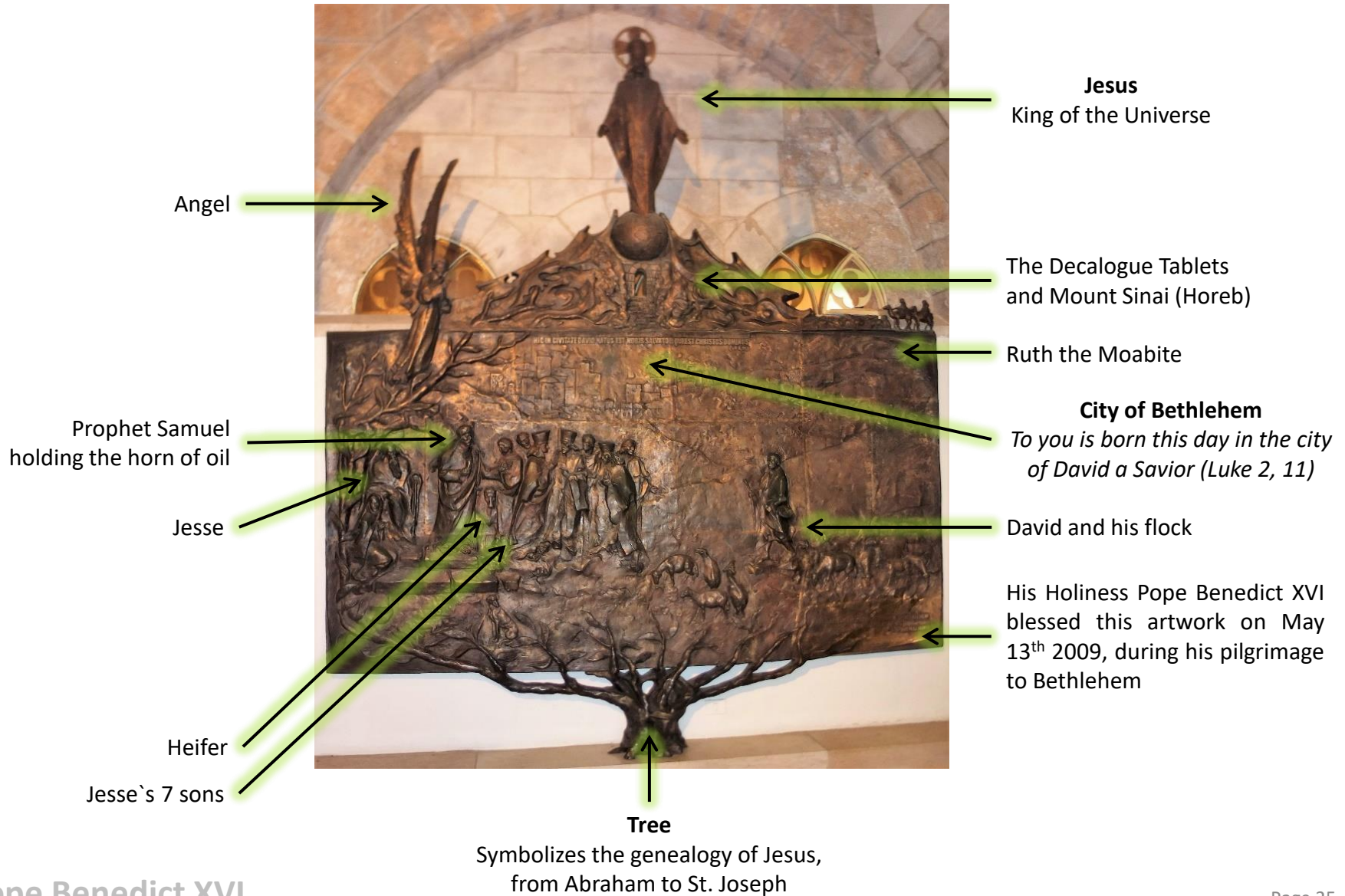
The artwork represents the visit of the prophet Samuel to Jesse (seated on the left side, surrounded by seven of his sons). On the right side we see David, the youngest son, arriving with his flock. The presence of the angel is to remind us that the promises made to David have been fulfilled with the Incarnation of the Son of God. The tree symbolizes the genealogy of Jesus Christ, who is represented as King of the Universe and is at the highest place in the sculpture.

His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI blessed this artwork on May 13th 2009, during his pilgrimage to Bethlehem.

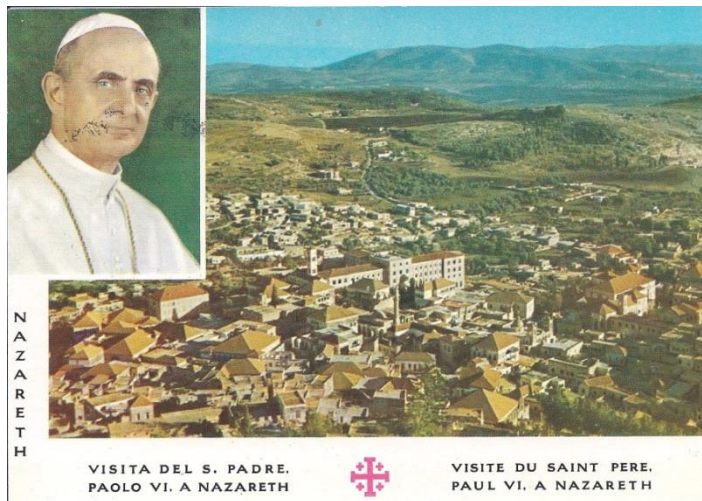

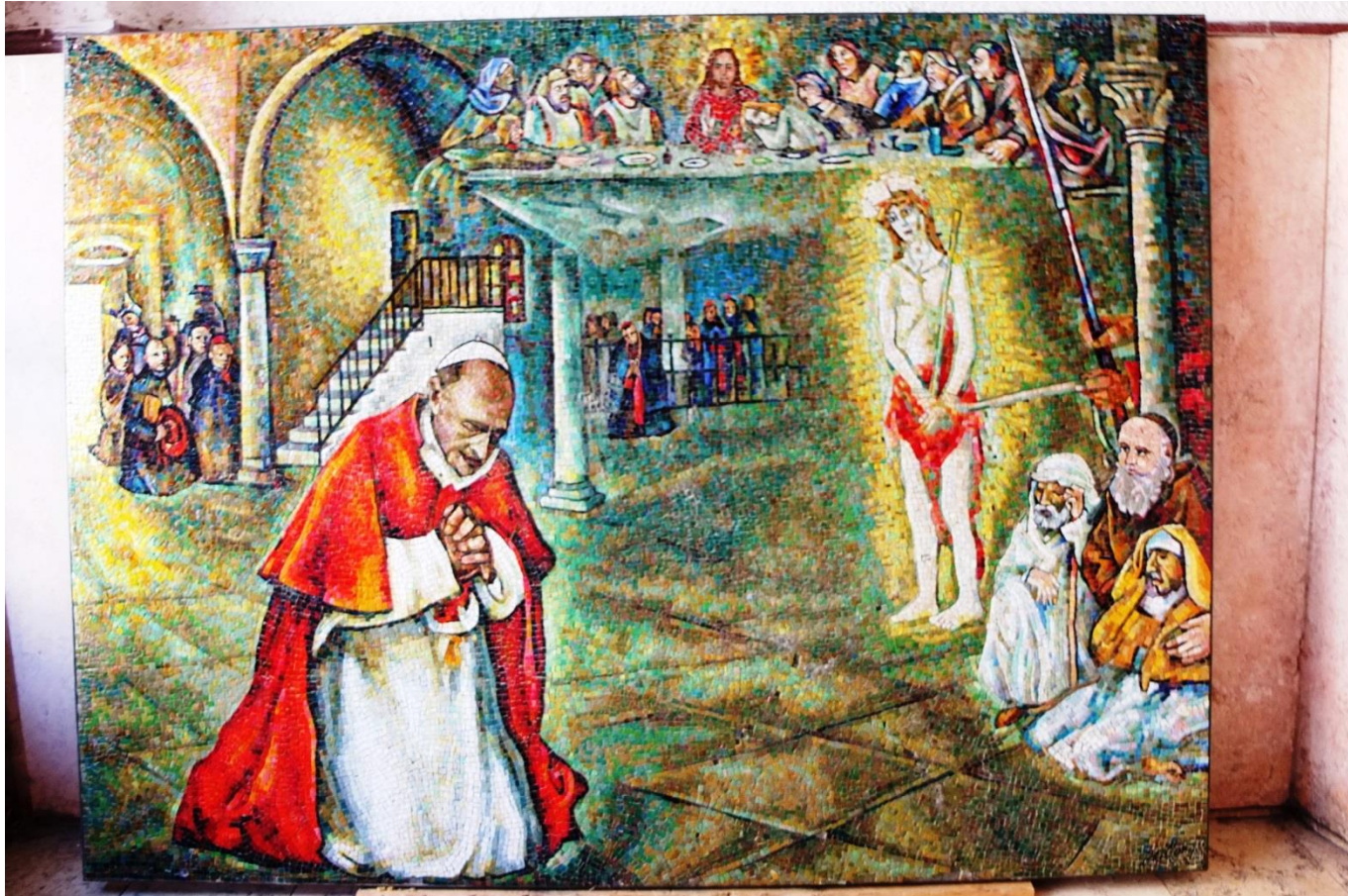

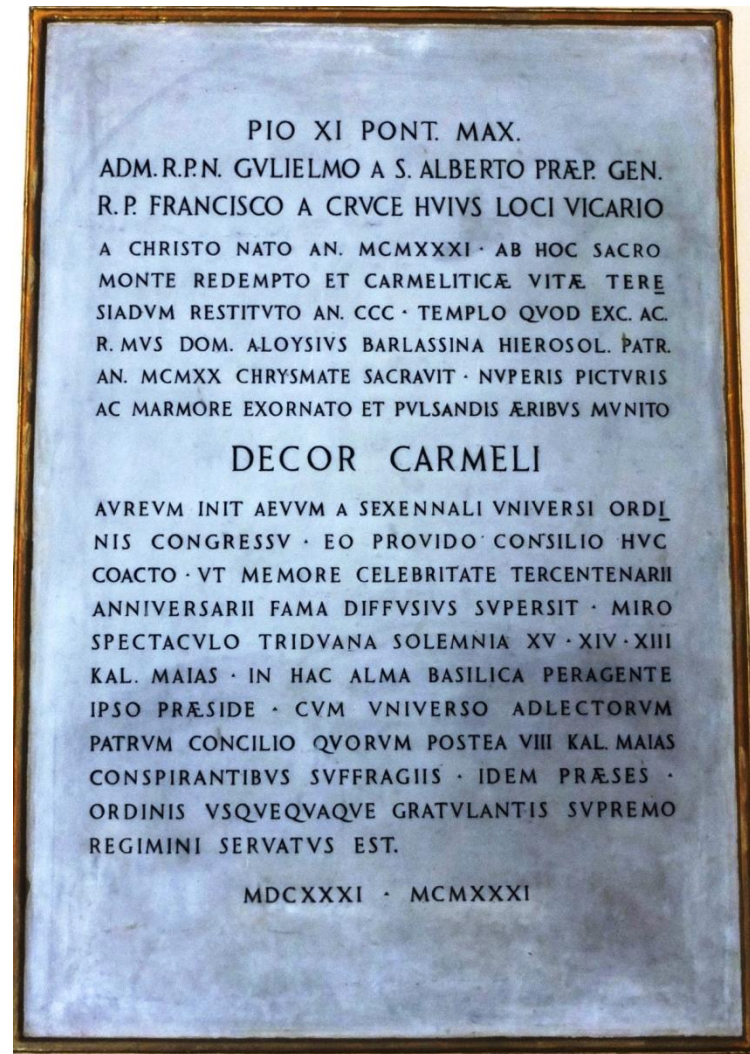

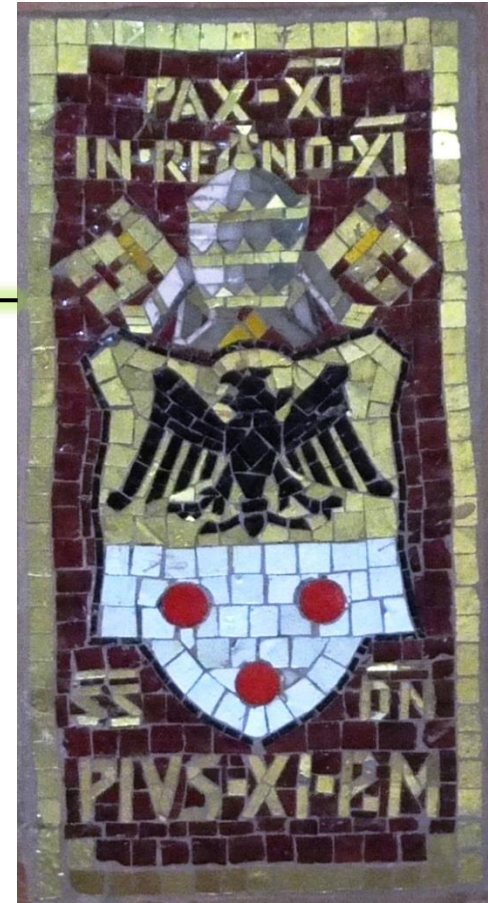

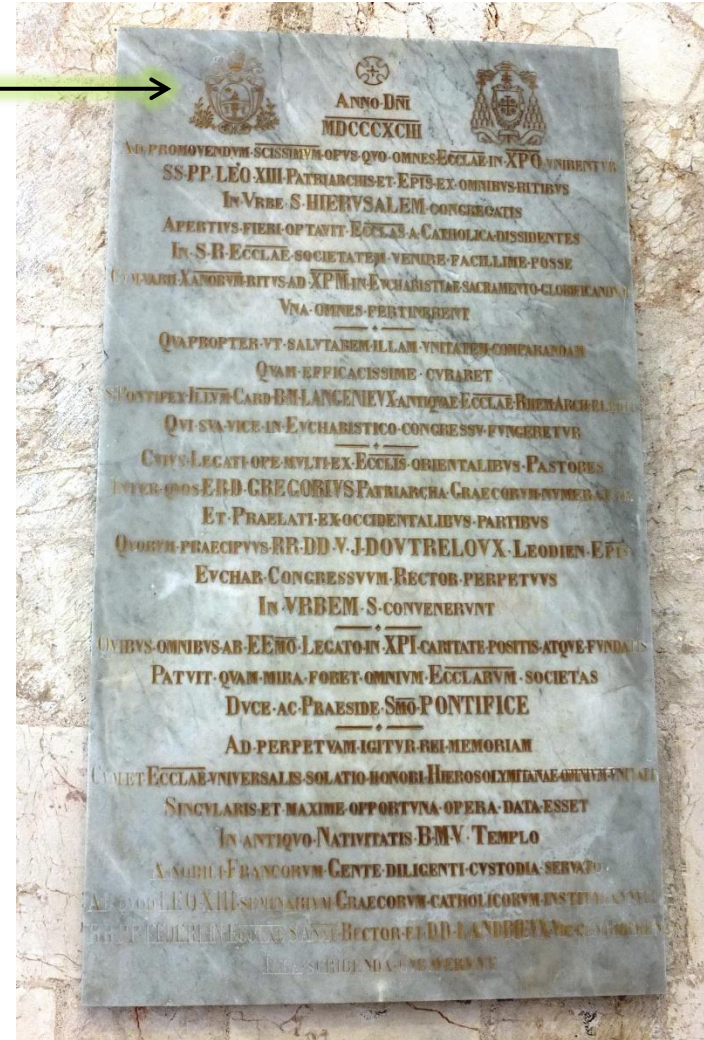

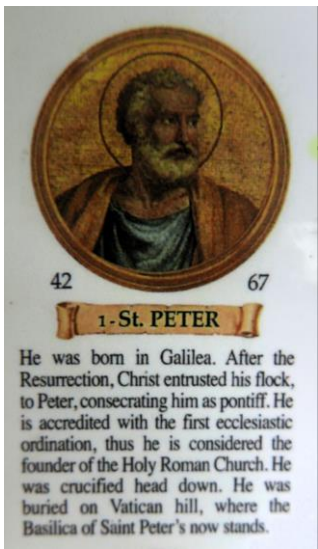

Summary

Jorge Mario Bergoglio was born in Argentina but of Italian origin. Bergoglio is the first from the American continent, and the first Pope to adopt a name that has never been used before by a predecessor. Bergoglio was elected Pope following the resignation of Benedict XVI. The Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy begins on the 8 December and ends on the 20 November 2016.
