*I am sending you to Jesse of Bethlehem, for I have chosen myself a king from among his sons (1 Samuel 16, 1-13)*

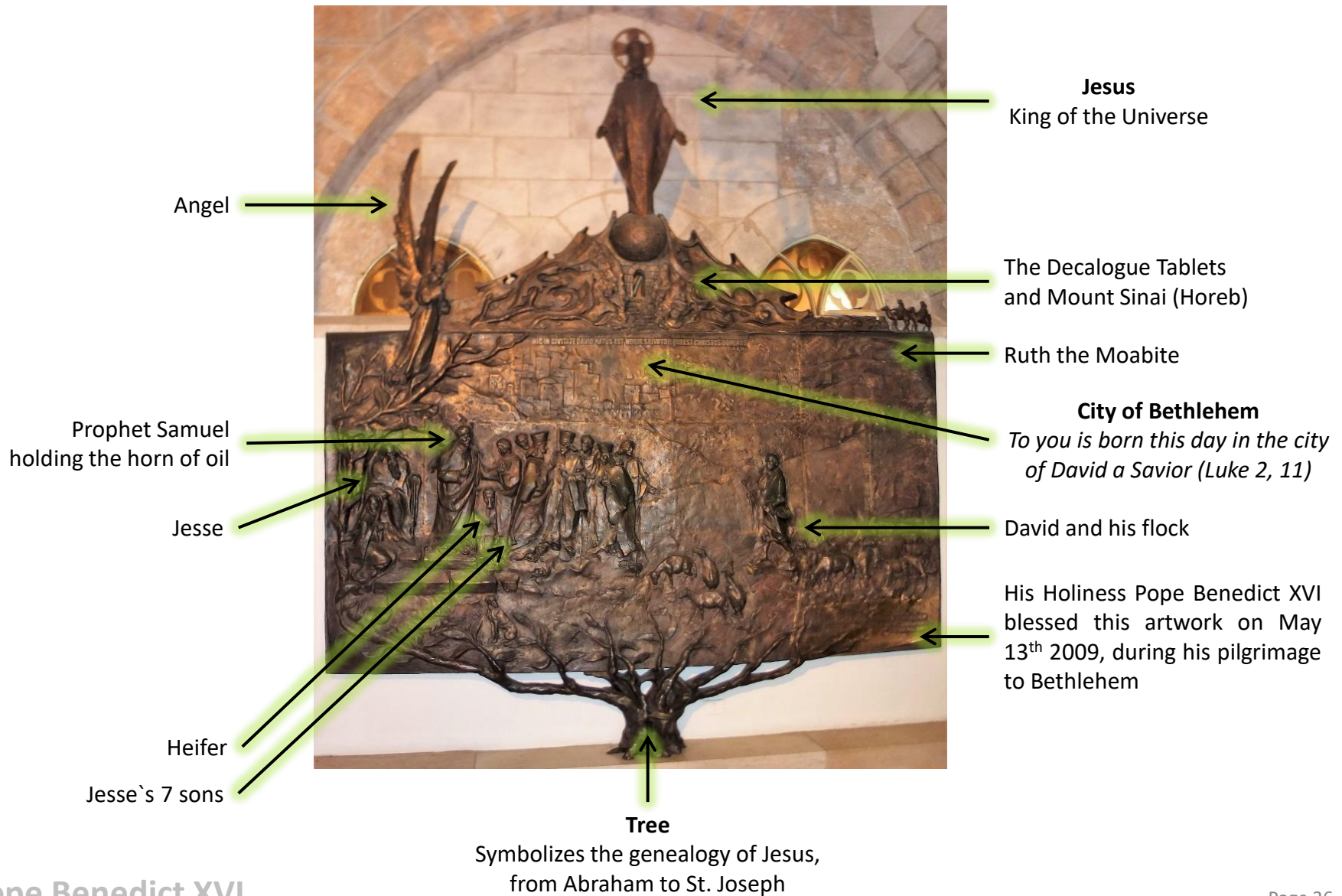
The artwork represents the visit of the prophet Samuel to Jesse (seated on the left side, surrounded by seven of his sons). On the right side we see David, the youngest son, arriving with his flock. The presence of the angel is to remind us that the promises made to David have been fulfilled with the Incarnation of the Son of God. The tree symbolizes the genealogy of Jesus Christ, who is represented as King of the Universe and is at the highest place in the sculpture.

His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI blessed this artwork on May 13<sup>th</sup> 2009, during his pilgrimage to Bethlehem.

In 1882 large groups of pilgrims began coming to the Holy Land under the direction of the Catholic religious Order of the Assumptionists. In 1885 the cornerstone of the building was placed with the intention of providing shelter to these growing groups of pilgrims. Following heavy damage in the war of 1967, the structure was rebuilt and renovated. Recognizing its historical, cultural, and spiritual value, in 1978, Pope John Paul II established the property as a Pontifical Institute and named it “Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.” Notre Dame’s mission continues to be that of offering hospitality to pilgrims and other services needed to live a profound spiritual experience. “Our Lady of Peace” chapel, found within the Center was consecrated in 1904, and is a place of peace, prayer and unity. This chapel is a spiritual oasis for pilgrims from all over the world. Notre Dame also directs a Hospitality and Education Training Section, specializing in providing local youth, with the tools necessary to enter the workforce. The Pontifical Institute engages as well in cultural activities, promoting exhibitions and offering its Auditorium for events.

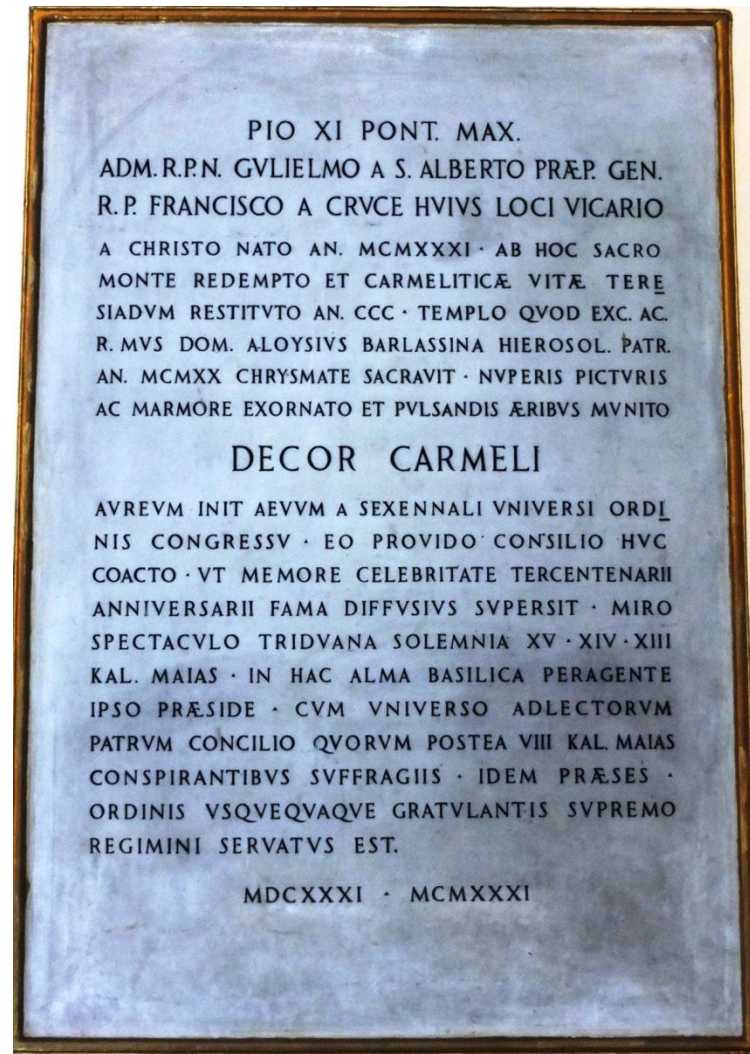

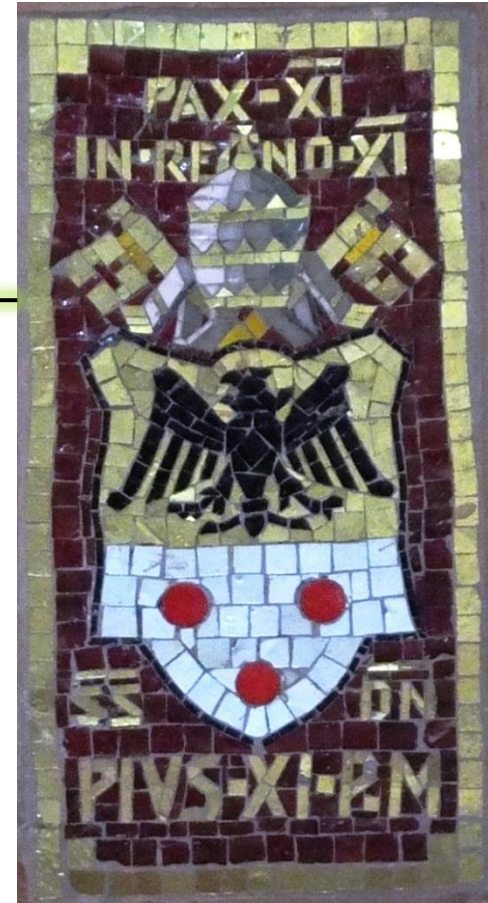

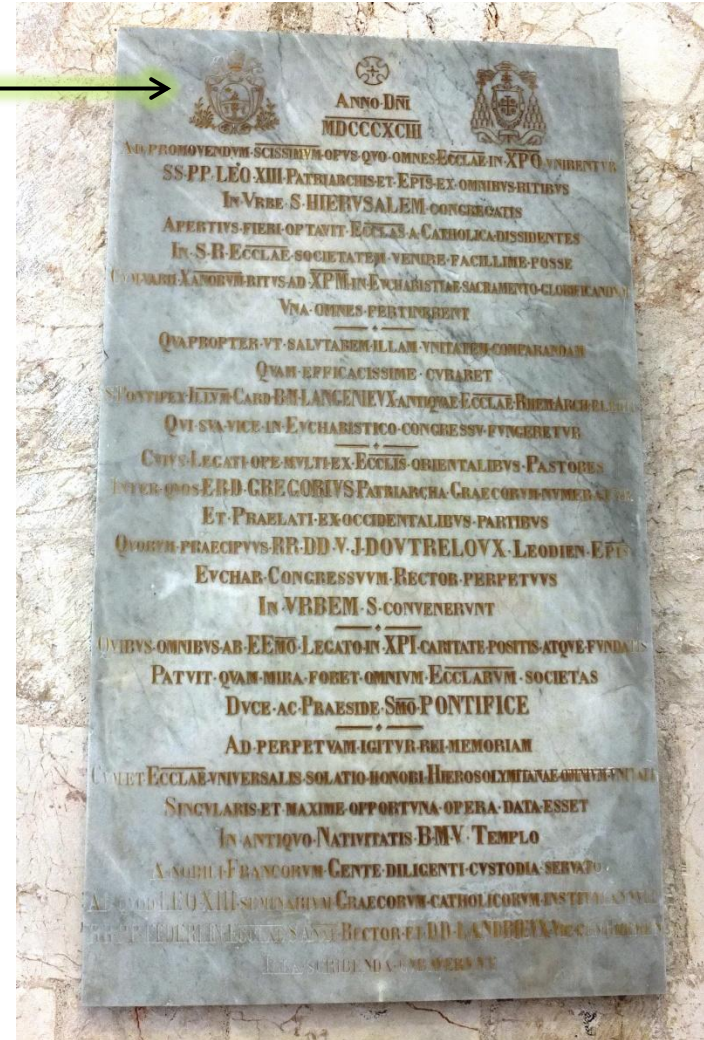
